1.1	Passport or travel document with validity not less than 6 months from the date of entry with <b>TWO BLANK PAGES</b> .

1.4	Confirmed tickets in and out of Thailand		
2	<b>Accommodation</b>		
2.1	Confirmed hotel/accommodation reservation in Thailand under the applicant's name		
2.2	Current residence or location proof		
3	<b>Proof of Adequate Finance</b>		
3.1	Financial evidence with an amount equivalent to no less than 500,000 THB or 1,000,000 INR, e.g. bank statements, sponsorship letter, pay slip.		
4	<b>Employment details</b>		
4.1	An employment contract or employment certificate in their country or professional portfolio showcasing digital nomad, remote worker, foreign talent or freelancer status		
5	<b>Proof of Thailand Inviter</b>		
5.1	Invitation letter from the company in Thailand to attend the activity (sport-related activity, cooking class, medical treatment, meeting, seminar, art performance)		
6	<b>Relation Proof</b>		
6.1	A relationship proof, e.g., a marriage certificate or birth certificate or adoption certificate (in case of a dependent or family member - spouse and children aged under 20 years)

In case of the visa is not granted, <b>the difference or the fee will not be refunded.</b>  **** <b>The Validity of a visa denotes the period during which a traveller can use the visa. The period of stay denotes the amount of time the traveler can stay in Thailand.</b>  ***** <b>An issuance of a visa from the Consulate does not guarantee entry into the Kingdom of Thailand. The Immigration Bureau will have sole discretion in allowing entry into the Kingdom of Thailand, subject to Thai laws and regulations.</b></p>
